

Citrus Cleaner



Materials:

Spray bottle

Glass jar with lid

Citrus peel (lemon, orange, mandarin, grapefruit, tangelos, lime...) to fill your size jar

White vinegar

Method:

In a wide neck glass jar fill it up with citrus peels (you can use some pulp and juice too – no need to be fussy).

Top the jar up with white vinegar to cover the peels.

Keep in a cool dark place. Cover and shake every day for two weeks.

Strain the liquid into a spray bottle.

Notes:

- Homemade vinegar not recommended as it's usually not strong enough
- Optional to add a few drops of your favourite essential oil
- Use full strength or diluted with water
- Cleans everything – floors, basins, benchtops, windows and toilets
- There's no expiry date, keep for as long as it takes to use up
